Sir,

With reference to above mentioned subject it is informed that Government of India has started 'Certificate Course in Community Health' for which curriculum has been designed by ICNOC. This course is being run for six months through Learner Support Centres (LSC's) which are either Medical College Hospitals or District/Sub-divisional Hospitals. The pass out candidates are posted as Community Health Officer (CHO) at the Health & Wellness Centres.


A review of the BSc Nursing curriculum has demonstrated that the vast majority of skills and competencies needed by a CHO are already part of the existing curriculum, but some areas need additional emphasis. A policy decision was taken at Govt. of India (GoI) level that the core competencies of the Certificate Program in Community Health would be integrated into the BSc/Post Basic BSc Nursing Curriculum, so that Graduating Nurses would be ready to assume the charge of a CHO if they successfully pass an appropriate competency test. This will enable the scaling up of Sub Health Centres to Health & Wellness Centres. Hence the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GoI has decided to incorporate curriculum of Certificate in Community Health into the existing curriculum of BSc/Post Basic BSc Nursing Curriculum, so that Graduating Nurses would be ready to apply for competency test meant for qualifying for the post of CHO. In this way lesser amount of time would be spent for eligibility of a CHO and our target of achieving No. of Health & Wellness Centres would be completed in the given time frame.

It is requested that clear instructions regarding adoption and integration of the course and full coverage of the integrated curriculum may be ensured. It may be emphasized upon educational institutes that this integration efforts is a key national priority in the implementation of Health & Wellness Centre Program under 'Ayushman Bharat' to make sure that the next batch of nurses passing out in July 2020 are eligible for Community Health Officers if they successfully pass an appropriate competency test.

I look forward to being appraised of the progress in this matter

Dear Sir,

As you are aware, under Ayushman Bharat, Health Team India is moving towards transformation of 1,50,000 Primary Health Centres and Sub-Health Centres into Health and Wellness Centres (AB-HWCs) by 2022 to provide comprehensive primary health care through these Centres. While the Primary Health Centre level AB-HWCs will continue to be headed by the Medical officer, the Sub Health Centre level AB-HWCs will be led by a Community Health Officer who is either a Nurse (GNM or B.Sc.) or an Ayurveda Practitioner trained for six months in a Certificate Programme for Community Health (CPCH), to gain competencies in a mix of public health and primary health care skills.

2. Earlier this year, the Indian Nursing Council (INC) - in collaboration with the Ministry and the National Health Systems Resource Centre (NHSRC) - after a rigorous review and comparison of the IGNOU curriculum with the Nursing curriculum concluded that the existing curricula included most of the competencies needed to lead the team and provide comprehensive primary care at the Sub Health Centre level AB-HWCs

3. The Committee constituted for this purpose recommended that a set of skills be reinforced for all nursing candidates of the four year B.Sc Nursing Course, in the given four years period. This will ensure that the key skills and competencies of the six month course are integrated into the B.Sc curriculum. This has been communicated by Indian Nursing Council (INC) to all the State Nursing Councils (Annexure-I).

4. I would like to request you to call a meeting of the State Nursing Councils and ensure that all Nursing Schools in the State are made aware of this new provision and take necessary measures to enable reinforcement of the necessary skills in the curriculum so that candidates graduating in July, 2020 are available to the States to be selected as Community Health Officers if they successfully pass an appropriate competency test. This will enable the scaling-up of Sub Health Centres to AB-HWCs in the given time frame.

5. I look forward to being appraised of the progress in this matter.

Dear Dr. Dileep,

As you are aware, transforming our existing 1,50,000 Sub Health Centres (SHC), Primary Health Centres (PHC) and Urban Primary Health Centres (UPHCs) to Health and Wellness Centres under Ayushman Bharat (AB-HWCs) is a key national priority. The HWCs at SHC level are to be led by a Community Health Officer (CHO). The CHOs are either a B.Sc/GNM or Ayurveda practitioners provided with an additional six month training through the Certificate Programme in Community Health (CPCH) currently being run through IGNOU and some State universities.

A review of the B.Sc Nursing Curriculum has demonstrated that the vast majority of skills and competencies needed by a CHO are already part of the existing curriculum, but some areas need additional emphasis. A policy decision was taken that the core competencies of the CPCH would be integrated into the B.Sc nursing curriculum, so that graduating nurses would be ready to assume the charge of a CHO as soon as they graduate.

I am happy to learn that the integration exercise for the long term and also for the immediate batches currently studying in the final year of their course has already been completed. However, it is also learnt and is a cause of concern that the changes incorporated in the curricula have not yet been communicated to all the universities and nursing colleges.

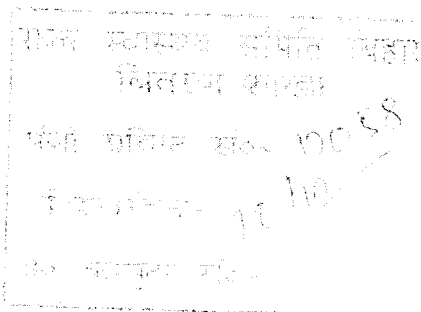
It is requested that clear instructions regarding adoption and integration of the course and full coverage of the integrated curricula may be ensured and may again be issued. It may be emphasized upon educational institutes that this integration effort is a key national priority in the implementation of AB-HWC programme to make sure that the next batch of nurses passing out in June 2020 are eligible for deployment as CHO.
